### What are Sash Horns?

Sash Horns are decorative 'haunches' that sit on the bottom rail of a window sash. A window 'Sash' is the opening part of the window. Horns are often found on old timber sliding sash windows or old timber casements.

Horns are available as an extra 'clip on' item or a welded 'run through' version. The 'run through' version is the most traditional looking option.

### Can any window have Sash Horns?

Sash Horns are restricted to sliding sash windows or top opening casement windows in instances where there is a fixed panel below. This is because the horns carry on below the standard welded corner of a window.

### How much will Sash Horns cost?

On the average top opening window, you will find clip on Sash Horns will cost you around £10 extra per Sash. If you opted for the run through Sash Horns, the cost per sash will be around £30, on average in White.




